

A Letter to Freshmen of Grade 2021 in Faculty of International Tourism and Management

Dear Freshmen,

Greetings!

First of all, congratulations to you all, the new students admitted in 2021, whose utmost diligence and wider effort bear fruit, having given yourselves a satisfactory answer at the crossroads of your lives by ushering in a new era of being students in Faculty of International Tourism and Management of City University of Macau.

Unveiling a new stage to you comes along a warm and sincere welcome from all the teachers and students of FITM. Welcome to this warm family!

In line with the mission of "promoting innovative teaching and scientific research, cultivating high-quality tourism talents, and fostering social harmony and prosperity", FITM has a vision with "good reputation and high influence in Macao and the Asia-Pacific region", enjoying "a high level of internationalization, distinctive features, and interactive development of industry-academia cooperation". The advocacy of high-quality teaching and scientific research as well as the support and funding for students' academic participation drive the fulfillment of being the first in Macao to achieve full coverage of the World Tourism Organization TedQual certification in undergraduate, master, and doctoral programs. After nearly a decade of development via efforts in teaching and research, academic activities and competitions, the FITM's programs have been ranked among the top 20% of the world's ranked universities in tourism and leisure management for two consecutive years in the "Shanghai Rankings Global Ranking of Academic Subjects 2020".

At present, cluster outbreaks have occurred in many places in China such that the risk and challenge of uncertainty of the epidemic is inevitable in the short term. In order to ensure the

physical and mental health and safety of our students, and in accordance with the latest requirements of the Macau Education and Youth Development Board, we regret that we are unable to meet with each freshman for the time being. Fortunately, we have arranged an online orientation session with you on 27th August via the Tencent Meeting platform (**Postgraduate Student**: 15:00-16:00, **Undergraduate Student**: 16:00-17:00). Please scan the QR code included in the attachment to gain access to the meeting. Additionally, all students will receive specific details via email.

We would like to explain the situation and requirements for all new students who are scheduled to be registered between 24th-26th August.

According to the relevant guidelines issued by the Education and Youth Development Bureau (DSEDJ), the class commencing date of the City University of Macau remains unchanged. If the epidemic situation is stable, face-to-face teaching will be resumed from 13 September (Monday), and online lessons will be mainly conducted before this date.

For the resumption of face-to-face teaching, students must follow the rules of Macau SAR and City University of Macau.

Those who return from outside Guangdong Province after 6 August:

- Must complete the nucleic acid test within 5 days before the start of school
- Must present the health code with negative nucleic acid test result when returning to the University for study

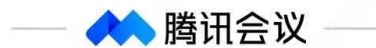
